# COMPANY 2021 SECONDARY DISTRIBUTOR PERMITS <u>DUE NOW!</u>

Companies that purchase and/or import regulated refrigerants and any new or used HVACR or air conditioning parts connected to the closed refrigerant loop of a system (see MR 103/94 or MOPIA's **Purchasing Bulletin and Regulated** Products Bulletin) must obtain a Secondary Distributor Permit annually via MOPIA. The annual permit cost is \$50 (currently) and upon receiving approval will be issued a Permit with a designated number allowing the company to purchase/acquire regulated products.
