



Mandatory Submission of Refrigerant Use Records for 2019

Every certified technician is required to submit their 2019 refrigerant (ODS) installation, repair and service records to MOPIA by February 1.

MOPIA has a generic form available on-line, or you may create your own with Excel or another program as long as it contains the following information:

- 1. Date of service provided
- 2. Type of refrigerant used
- 3. Amount of refrigerant charged, recovered or recharged
- 4. Location of work
- 5. Short description of work performed
- 6. Reference work order or invoice

For those who have not used any refrigerant(s) during 2019, MOPIA requires you as a certified technician to notify us that none has been used as your submission.

MOPIA will be hosting our next one-day certification class on on Saturday, February 1st in Winnipeg. Any person working on the gas side of an air conditioning, and/or HVAC/R system requires this provincial certification under Manitoba Regulation 103/94.

Persons who require this certification should register in advance by contacting MOPIA by email (mopia@mymts.net) or phone (1.888.667.4203). The cost of participating is \$185 per student.

The one-day class typically runs from 8 am - 5 pm with the exam. For those unable to attend an onsite/in-class setting, living in remote rural communities or other circumstances, you may be eligible to do the class via correspondence.

2020 Secondary Distributor Renewals Due Now!

Companies that import or purchase regulated ODS products in/to Manitoba are required to have a Secondary Distributor (SD) Permit. This applies to companies from auto dealerships, Ag implement, wholesalers and anyone else that handles regulated air conditioning or HVACR equipment, refrigerant and/or parts.

The SD Permit is an annual permit, having been in place since the Manitoba ODS Regulation came into existence (1993). It can easily be applied for, or renewed, only through MOPIA. The cost for the 2020 SD Permit is unchanged at \$50.
