Nobel Laureate Mario Molina who's research, alongside Sherwood Rowland, was instrumental in highlighting chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) destroy the stratospheric ozone, died in October. His research led to the formation of the Vienna Convention and the Montreal Protocol and its' ultimate protection.

This wallet size card is mandatory for all persons servicing or purchasing regulated refrigerant(s), part(s) and equipment.

The card is issued annually and is needed when purchasing refrigerant or parts on the gas side of new or used refrigeration or air conditioning systems. Companies with a valid Secondary Distributor (SD) Permit may also purchase regulated products. o company S.D. Permit? No card? NO SALE!

No Certification Card or Secondary Distributor Permit means - No Sale! Cards and Permits are not transferable.

Tough Penalties Penalties exist for anyone purchasing and/or selling regulated products without a valid Certification Card. You may verify a card's validity by contacting MOPA.

Wholesalers & Distributors Anyone selling regulated new or used air conditioning and refrigeration equipment, parts and/or refrigerant are obligated to see and record a MB-number of a valid Cetification Cet
