Ozone Hero Mario Molina Passes



MOPIA is sad to hear of the recent passing of Dr. Mario Molina on October 7 at age 77, a former chemist from Mexico who in 1974 co-authored an article in the Journal "Nature" raising to light the impact of CFCs on the ozone layer.

He was challenged by big industry and met resistance of the theory, which he persevered for the benefit of all humans. He won the Noble Prize (1995) and set into motion the efforts of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) including The Montreal Protocol known as the globes most successful environmental treaty.

The Government of the Province of British Columbia (BC) has moved forward with the set-up of the Major Appliance Recovery Roundtable (MARR) to coordinate the implementation of a provincial appliance stewardship program.

A new Administrative Fee is set to be applied on the purchase of new appliances.


This fee will support the proper recovery, recycling and disposal of appliances in BC.
