

World Ozone Day 2018



Many millions around the globe have been protected from the harmful effects of ozone depletion.

From refrigerants to foam products, fire protection agents, solvents and agriculture fumigants, all have seen significant changes since about 1989 onwards. The challenges remain as many ozone depleting substances were substituted with chemicals that contribute to climate change.

The Worlds' most successful international environmental treaty (The Montreal Protocol) has shaped progress on ozone, with the most recent Kigali Amendment (2016) aiming to address climate change, beginning in 2019.

September 16 is World Ozone Day. Check out what is happening around the Earth to recognize this day.

September 29th Certification Class




MOPIA will be hosting our next one-day certification class in Winnipeg at Red River College on Saturday, September 29. Anyone working on the gas side of an air conditioning/refrigeration system must have this certification. In Manitoba, over 15,000 people have received certification since 1993 -- and well over 100,000 across Canada.

You must register in advance by contacting MOPIA. The cost of participating is \$185 per student.

The class typically runs from 8 am - 6 pm with the exam. The aim is to ensure all services are in compliance with the Manitoba ODS Regulation (i.e. no topping up, leak checking is done, etc.).

Point of No Return is 2035?



The European Geosciences Union, (an international union of 15,000 scientists/members based in Munich, Germany) issued a Press Release on August 30, 2018 highlighting that humanity is heading to the point of no return on climate change if action is not taken now to limit global warming to 2C by 2100.

This follows from another climate change related article warning known as the Hothouse Earth Pathway in August of this year entitled "Trajectories of the Earth System in the Anthropocene" published in the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences of the USA.
