Vienna Convention MONTREAL PROTOCOL

There have been 5 amendments to the Montreal Protocol since its implementation in 1987. These include the London, Copenhagen, Montreal, Beijing and Kigali Amendments, each with specific and important international commitments. The Kigali amendment marked the inclusion of HFCs, aiming to eliminate their global production as they were identified as potent greenhouse gases.


Many health and economic benefits have been observed, and are further projected with the on-going implementation of the Montreal Protocol and its amendments.

The economic health benefits have yielded an estimated US\$1.8 trillion from the reduction of skin cancers, eye cataracts, and US\$460 billion in safeguarding crop yields, fisheries, and materials alone.

Successful Prosecutions by Enforcement

Environment and Climate Change Canada continues to post and make known successful prosecutions they have made across Canada. The most recent being in February 12, 2025 against a person violating 2 Canadian Environmental Laws. Those persons/companies that neglect, breach or overlook their environmental responsibilities here in Manitoba may face both provincial and federal prosecution.

In Manitoba, companies must have a Secondary Distributor (SD) Permit for importing or purchasing regulated A/C and refrigeration parts, equipment and refrigerants. Technicians must be certified to handle any regulated products and work on any equipment or components that make up or are attached to the closed refrigerant loop.

Companies who must hold an SD Permit include wholesalers and regulated products sellers, auto shops/dealers servicing A/C, ag implement dealers, and many others. In some cases, an SD Permit may not be needed for sole owner-operators of smaller scale businesses. Please contact MOPIA for details.
