WHAT IS CHLOROPICRIN?

Chloropicrin is a chemical used primarily in agriculture as a soil fumigant, broad spectrum antimicrobial, herbicide, insecticide, fungicide, and nematicide. It is also used as a chemical warfare agent. Its use has expanded in the agricultural sector as a replacement for methyl bromide which was phased out due to its ozone depleting characteristics. The primary purpose of the chemical is to kill bacteria and any insects that may harbor on plants including commonly consumed fruits and vegetables including raspberries. strawberries, almonds, peppers, tomatoes, melons and orchard trees.
