The Ozone Secretariat, a specialized unit part of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), coordinates and hosts this important annual event that invites and brings together policy makers and political leaders from every nation on earth to discuss, review and formalize policy on controls of harmful substances affecting those in a multitude of industry sectors.

'25 Climate Change Conference COP 30

Climate Change



The 2025 United Nations climate change conference is happening November 10th -21st in Belém, Brazil. This meeting will be the 10 year anniversary of the Paris Agreement.

The agenda key points will focus on fossil fuel phase down, deforestation and energy efficiency. It is also expected that Brazil's Minister of the Environment and Climate Change Marina Silva suggested that the summit could result in a roadmap to guide away from fossil fuels. This roadmap could require all countries to report concrete targets and timelines for the phasing out of fossil fuels along with accompanying measures and policies. 2024 was the warmest year on record and it is expected that more emphasis will be put towards COP 30 then was at COP 29.

Canada will be attending COP 30 and will have its own pavilion where Canada will demonstrate its act for climate action and low carbon economic development. This platform will also allow for different provinces and territories to have a platform to speak on its individual ideas.

White Goods Decommissioning

White goods must have its' ODS refrigerant recovered before the unit is crushed or sent to a shredder or recycling facility.
