The World Meteorological Organization (WMO) just released its Scientific Ozone Assessment of Ozone Depletion for 2022. This report highlights the significant successes of the Montreal Protocol, new policy considerations and current challenges such as unexpected emissions of CFC-11.


MOPIA ATTENDING MOP 34 IN MONTREAL


