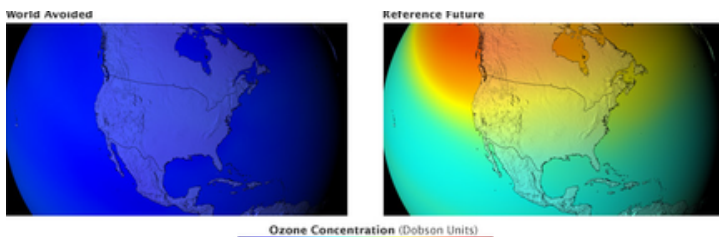

At present, and in Manitoba there are just over 6700 persons certified to handle regulated refrigerants and new and used air conditioning and refrigeration equipment. There are also 550 companies that hold 2022 Secondary Distributor permit, allowing them to purchase and or import regulated products into Manitoba.

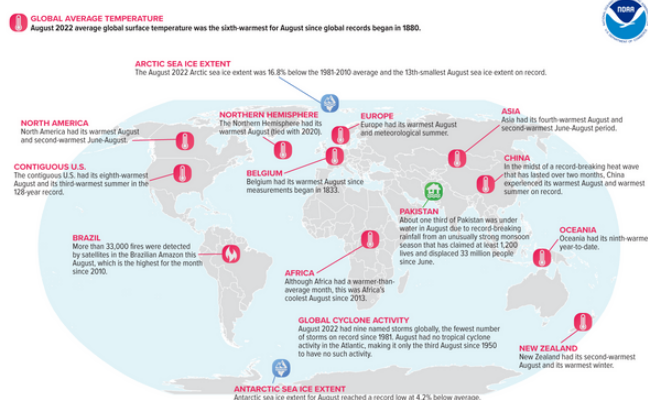
